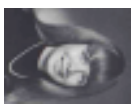


and goes to great lengths to hide his whereabouts. He will, however, be at the reunion—he will just be difficult to find and identify.



Nancy Prins: For those who do not know, prim and proper Nancy's email and internet handle is "NastyNancy". You are all forewarned.



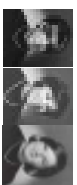

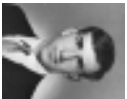

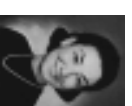
What Have They Been Up To?

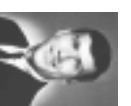
